VARIOUS ROADS, DOVER & THANET

(SPEED LIMITS)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

For the safety of the public by avoiding congestion and ensuring smooth traffic flows during The 149th Open (Golf Championship), Kent County Council has made an Order to impose temporary mandatory speed limits on various roads in East Kent.

Compulsory speed limits will be imposed on the roads below, to the maximum extent defined.

All speed limits will apply as and when and to the extent clearly indicated by relevant speed limit signs displayed on site.

A256 WHITFIELD BYPASS – Northbound only – 50 mph from a point 50 metres south of the junction with Kennel Hill northwards to a point 50 metres south of the roundabout junction with Barville Road

A256 WHITFIELD BYPASS – Northbound only – 40 mph from a point 50 metres south of the roundabout junction with Barville Road northwards to the overbridge directly due east of St Mary's Grove.

A256 WHITFIELD BYPASS – Northbound only – 30 mph from a point in line with the overbridge directly due east of St Mary's Grove northwards to a point 50 metres north of Eastry Roundabout (junction with Dover Road, Eastry)

A256 SANDWICH ROAD – 40 mph in both directions northbound from a point approximately 100 metres south-west of the roundabout junction with A258 Deal Road

A256 SANDWICH BYPASS – 40 mph in both directions southbound from a point approximately 100 metres north-west of the roundabout junction with A258 Deal Road

A258 DEAL ROAD – 40 mph in both directions northbound from a point approximately 100 metres south of the roundabout junction with A258 Deal Road / Deal Road

A258 DEAL ROAD – 40 mph in both directions eastbound between the roundabout junction with A256 Sandwich Road / Sandwich Bypass and the roundabout junction with A258 Deal Road / Deal Road

A299 HENGIST WAY, RAMSGATE – 50 mph eastbound only, from the existing 50 mph / national speed limit signs east of Minster Roundabout (Mount Pleasant) eastwards for approximately 1 kilometre.

A299 HENGIST WAY – 40 mph eastbound only from the end of the 50 mph speed limit defined above extending eastwards to and including Cliffsend Roundabout

A299 HENGIST WAY – 40 mph in both directions from Cliffsend Roundabout southwards towards Sevenscore for approximately 110 metres

BARVILLE ROAD, WALDERSHARE / EASTRY - 40 mph from the roundabout junction with A256 Whitfield Bypass in both directions, westwards to the existing 30 mph speed limit east of the junction with Pike Road

DEAL ROAD, SANDWICH – 30 mph from the roundabout junction with A258 Deal Road in both directions, northwards to the existing 30mph speed limit south of the entrance to Delf Farm Shop

DOVER ROAD, EASTRY – 30 mph from the roundabout junction with A256 Whitfield Bypass / Eastry Bypass in both directions, northwards to the existing 30 mph speed limit south of the junction with Pike Road / Northbourne Road

This Order comes into force from Sunday 11 July 2021 and remains valid until conclusion of The 149th Open, no later than Monday 19 July 2021.

The restrictions will need to remain in force at all times during the above period.
