**PIKE ROAD, TILMANSTONE**

**(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)**

**TEMPORARY ORDER 2021**

**To allow works to be carried out to provide a new water connection, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Pike Road, Tilmanstone, in the Dover area.**

**A closure is currently planned from Monday 16 August 2021 for up to 3 days.**

**Pike Road will be closed in the general vicinity of Lower Venson Farm, north of the junction with Venson Lane, to the actual extent shown.**

**The alternative route for through traffic is via Thornton Road, Thornton Lane, Heronden Road, Mill Lane and Lower Street back to Pike Road.,**

**Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.**

**The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.**
