(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow works to be carried out to provide utility connections to supply new properties, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of The Street, Woodnesborough, Sandwich.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 23 August 2021, with estimated completion by 4 September 2021.

The Street will be closed between the junctions with Woodland Way and Melville Lea, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via The Street, Sandwich Road, Woodnesborough Road, St Bart's Road, Dover Road, A258 Deal Road, Sandwich Road, Statenborough Lane, Foxborough Hill and Fir Tree Hill and vice versa.

Local access to the remainder of The Street continues from either direction up to where the road is actually closed.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
