**WOODNESBOROUGH LANE,
EASTRY, SANDWICH**

(PROHIBITION OF DRIVING)

TEMPORARY ORDER 2021

To allow water maintenance works to be carried out, Kent County Council has made an Order to temporarily prohibit through traffic on part of Woodnesborough Lane, Eastry, near Sandwich.

A closure is currently planned from Monday 23 August 2021, with estimated completion by 27 August 2021.

Woodnesborough Lane will be closed in the general vicinity of the junction with Sandwich Road, to the actual extent shown on site.

The alternative route for through traffic is via Sandwich Road, Statenborough Lane and Gore Lane.

Local access to the remainder of Woodnesborough Lane continues from Statenborough Lane.

Due to the nature of the works, it will not be possible to re-open the road outside the working hours.

The planned dates and duration may change for various reasons including the current coronavirus situation and adverse weather conditions, with any changes signposted on site and notified locally.
